HKACE 2011 is a seminar for the Hong Kong air cargo industry. It aims to provide a forum for academics and people in the industry to exchange their experiences, views, and visions of the air cargo industry. Furthermore, the results of the Innovation and Technology Fund (ITF) project entitled "Enhancing the Competitiveness of the Hong Kong Air Freight Forwarding Industry Using RFID and Software Agent Technologies" will be presented. These include the results of a Hong Kong – Taiwan RFID Pilot Run Test.
