Opening Session

Plenary Session 1- Shaping the Future of Asia: The Emerging Dragons

Regional economic integration is on the cards as the Association of Southeast Asian Nations aims to establish the ASEAN Economic Community (AEC) and become a single market by 2015. This session will assess the macroeconomic outlook for the maritime and logistics industries, and analyse AEC's impact on regional trade flows and address the implications of growing trade between China and ASEAN.

Plenary Session 2- Retail Revolution: A Brave New World

Traditional models are fading in importance with the rise of e-tailing and mobile commerce. E-commerce is changing where, when and how goods are produced – all of which will overturn the conventional truths about supply chains. Hear experts discuss the impact that the new consumerism is having on logistics and supply chain management, as well as on the shipping community.

Breakout Session 1- Unlocking China's Potential

Despite its huge size and potential, the Chinese market is full of challenges for both international shippers and local logistics providers. Chinese experts will focus on the mainland's infrastructure development, including railways and new transport hubs, and their impact on distribution networks.

Breakout Session 2- Smooth Sailing for Asia's Maritime Industry

With the continued growth of Asian consumer demand and intra-regional trade, shippers are looking to take advantage of the efficiencies by coordinating berthing at multiple Asian ports, creating a crisscrossing network that presents new challenges for the maritime industry. This session will explore how maritime industry players should adapt and position themselves to maximise the opportunities arising from this trend.

Breakout Session 3- The Sky's the Limit for Asian Air Freight

What does booming trade between Asia and other emerging economies mean for the air cargo industry? This session will also focus on the challenges of small order and just-in-time requirements, and the implications of the latest air cargo security regulations.

Breakout Session 4- Recipes for the Food Supply Chain

This session will put the spotlight on cold chain developments in emerging markets, including the Chinese mainland. The panellists will share their experience and case studies, with particular attention paid to food safety, quality compliance for perishable goods, and managing a seamless and cost-effective food supply chain.
