The ISO 28000 series of standards on supply chain security management systems will help to reduce risks to people and cargo within the supply chain. The standards address potential security issues at all stages of the supply process, thus targeting threats such as terrorism, fraud and piracy. This provides a global solution to this global problem, while facilitating international trade, thus contributing to the welfare of society as a whole.

The development of this standard improves the broader interface with existing enterprise risk management in a common integrated platform thus providing better coordinate cross functional risk management mechanisms, improve performance measurement, ensure continual improvement and reducing misalignment of risk management objectives between difference sectors of business operations.

This standard can be applied by organizations of all sizes involved in manufacturing, service, storage or transportation by air, rail, road and sea at any stage of the production or supply process. The series includes provisions to establish, implement, maintain and improve a security management system, to assure conformity with enterprise risk management policy, to demonstrate such conformity of an organization, to make a self-determination and self-declaration of conformity, and also seek certification/registration of conformity by an accredited third party organization.
